Local fundraising with GEICO

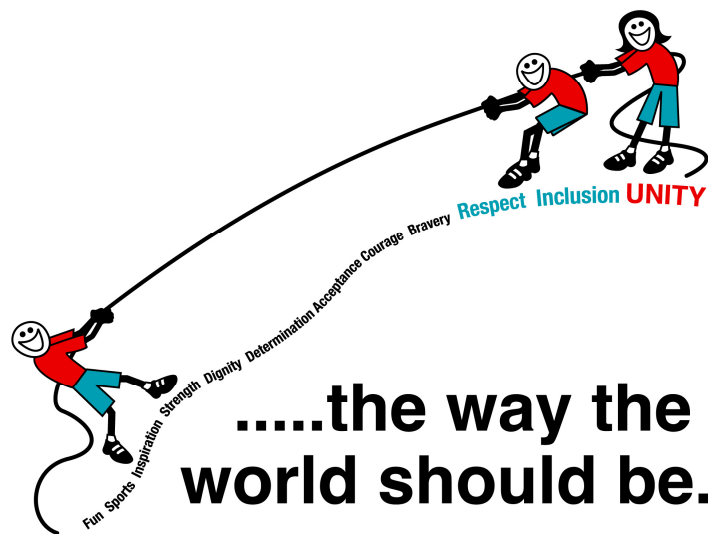
